

Behaviour Log

This is used throughout the school to log and monitor pupil behaviour.



It is monitored by the Senior Management Team and a new log sheet is started termly allowing children to have a fresh start.

Pupils' names are put into the Behaviour Log if they get a Stage 3 or Stage 4.

Golden Tickets

Children will be awarded 2 House points for a Golden Ticket and these tickets are put into the Golden Time Raffle Box.

Each week 15 tickets will be picked at the assembly and those children will win a special prize. This could be a tea party, iPad time or games with Mrs Matrin and Mrs Thain.



Platinum Tickets

A Platinum Ticket is rewarded for whole class positive behaviours. Each term two classes with the highest number of Platinum Tickets; one from the upper school and one from the infant school, is rewarded with a special prize. This could be a picnic trip to Duthie Park.

Behaviour Log Steps

Step 1

Verbal Warning (2 in the infant classes)

Step 2

Warning Card

Step 3

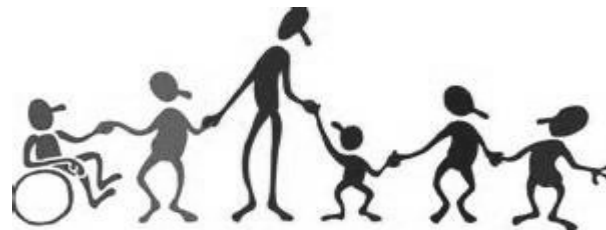
'Stop and Think Exercise' completed in another class for 10 minutes and sent home. To be returned the next day. No return and child stays in at break to complete. If more than 3 in a week the child will move to a Stage 4.

Step 4

Sent to SMT and 'Rights Respecting Schools' Exercise' sent home to be returned the next day. No return and child stays in at break to complete.

Step 5

If a child gets more than three Stage 4s in a term SMT will arrange a meeting with parents/carers to discuss how we can support your child further.

Class Charters

These will be created with the children and are linked to the Rights of the Child. Each class may operate their own additional reward systems to promote positive behaviour.

House System

Broomhill School operates a House System for all children P1-7 to reward and encourage positive behaviour. The houses are:

House Points

House Points are awarded for:

- Upholding the school's vision and ethos
- Pupil of the Week

- Respecting the rights of other children



House Rewards

Points will be collected by the P7 House Captains each week and announced at the weekly assemblies.



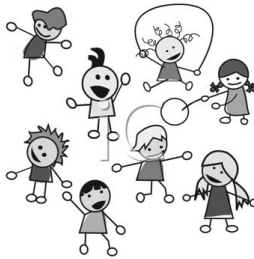
The winning house will receive a House Reward at the end of the school session.

Classes have their own points systems. Points will be given as a positive reward for pupils who are on track, helping others and working hard.



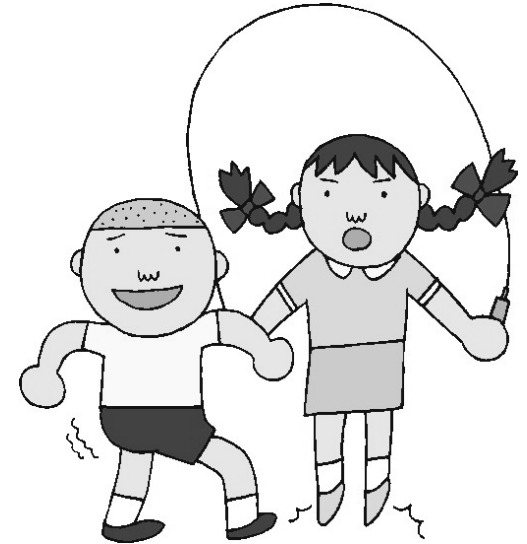
Golden Time
